SUBJECT: AREA COMMITTEE FINANCIAL UPDATE
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Short description of report content and the decision requested:

At the start of this financial year, the South East Area Committee had a further £18,200 allocated for 2018/19, bringing the total budget available to spend on the priorities of its Area Action Plan to £27,363.16.

Appendix 1 sets out the current financial position of the South East Area Committee and is for noting only.

The Area Committee has the option to devolve up to 10% of its annual budget to establish a 'Making a Difference' (MAD) Budget for small scale community initiatives; a 10% allocation would equate to £600 per ward for 2018/19.

The MAD budget spends for 2017/18 are set out in Appendix 1, totalling £549.90 and resulting in an underspend of £1,250.10.

It is requested that the Area Committee:

- (i) Notes the financial statement in Appendix 1;
- (ii) Determines the allocation of funding to establish a Making a Difference (MAD) budget for 2018/19;
- (iii) Approves the return of the unspent MAD funding for 2017/18 (£1,250.10) to the main unallocated South East Area Committee budget.
