1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Strategic Overview & Scrutiny Committee is required to produce an Annual Report to Council on its activities (and that of its Sub-Committees) throughout the year.

- 1.3 The Constitution also requires that as soon as it is reasonably possible after the start of each Council year, a work programme detailing the matters the Committee proposes to scrutinise during that year should be presented to Council for information. However, the Strategic Overview & Scrutiny Committee need not keep to the approved Work Programme.
- 1.4 Attached, as **Appendix 2** is the 2019-20 Work Programme which is submitted as an item to each Overview & Scrutiny Committee, to allow for items to be added or removed.

2. Background

- 2.1 The Annual Report gives an overview of scrutiny work and investigations carried out over the year 2018-2019 under the chairmanship of Councillor Liz Harsant.
- 2.2 The Steering Group with membership made up of the lead Councillors from each political group continued to discuss meetings to coincide with the preparation of the agenda for the next Strategic Overview and Scrutiny committee meeting and were instrumental in ensuring that the scope for each scrutiny topic was clear.
- 2.3 The Committee also agreed to continue with the use of Task & Finish Groups to undertake process reviews to bring together customers, Councillors and officers in a review of key frontline processes in order to improve service delivery from an external customer focused perspective. The method used was as follows:- a proposal form would commission a review by the Overview & Scrutiny Steering Group which would be submitted at the Work Programme item to the Committee. Following discussion, the Overview & Scrutiny Committee would either request that an item be placed on a future agenda or that a Task & Finish Group be convened, with appropriate Councillors, who would scope a review.
- 2.4 The benefits of this approach saw Officers, Councillors and customers working together in a different and more dynamic way to identify improvements to service delivery. This approach also maintained a discipline of service improvements through a process of external challenge and provided the Strategic Overview & Scrutiny Committee with an effective means by which it could scrutinise service delivery.
