The Young Gainsborough: Rediscovered Landscape Drawings will focus on the young Gainsborough as a landscape artist and the centrepiece of the exhibition will be 25 recently reattributed Gainsborough drawings from the Royal Collection. Firm attribution to Gainsborough was the focus of press attention in 2017, featuring on BBC Radio 4's Today programme. For the first time these drawings will now be publicly displayed.

Gainsborough's *Pool in the Woods* will be displayed in a section devoted to Gainsborough's response to Dutch landscape, alongside two of the Royal Collection drawings.
